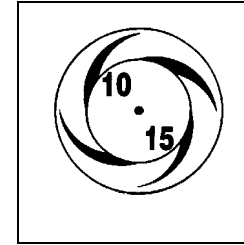
10-15 Transit is a coordinated transportation service with the ability to serve the general public, as well as, service organizations within the ten county area.

Type of Service

10-15 Transit is a federally funded PUBLIC transportation system. The Iowa Department of Transportation provides operating assistance for public transportation. Service is available to ANYONE needing transportation.

10-15 Transit provides door-to-door and established route service. The fleet consists of lift-equipped vehicles making the system accessible to anyone.

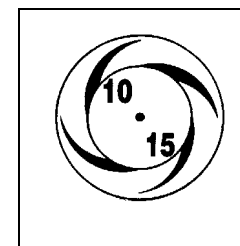
